Alerion:

- A third (114 MW) wind farm is authorised at the
 Vulturu site in Romania
- This plant completes the authorisation for a project consisting of three wind farms with a total capacity of 336 MW

Milan, 26 June 2024 – Alerion Clean Power S.p.a., through its indirect subsidiary Energo Windprod S.r.l., has obtained authorisation for the construction of a 114 MW wind farm in the Crucea, Saraiu and Vulturu municipalities of the Dobrogea region of Romania.

This plant forms part of and completes a project consisting of three adjacent wind farms with a total capacity of approximately 336 MW, the first two of which have already been authorised (see press release dated 13 May 2024).

It is estimated that the plants will enter into production in 2027 and that the expected production of the entire wind power project at full capacity (including the three plants) will be approximately 1,100 GWh per year, with an annual EBITDA of approximately €85 million.
